



**HOUSE RULES AND REGULATIONS**  
**SWIMMING POOL AREA**

- 1) PARKING is available at the pool. NO vehicles permitted past chain at pool
- 2) DO NOT OPERATE POOL EQUIPMENT YOURSELF.
- 3) Note POOL-, PLAYGROUND RULES & ASSEMBLY POINT boards at common areas.
- 4) NO GLASS please!! Only plastic glasses or tinned drinks permitted in and around the pool. Get one from the MALL if needed.
- 5) Feel free to bring some pool toys / floats and chairs for the pool area.
- 6) Wooden lawn dominoes, "tic-tac-toe" and jenga available to use at the pool.
- 7) Please make use of the lovely cleared shaded areas and benches or braais under the trees at the pool
- 8) We now have 2 UNISEX toilets at the pool. Please feel free to use the "Lapa Loo" beyond the boma area at the lodge as well. Follow ABLUTION SIGNS on the paved walkways.
- 9) The boma and upstairs deck is for the use by lodge residents ONLY.
- 10) BE FIRE CONSCIOUS

**WHAT IS THERE TO DO?**

- 1) GAME DRIVES - Please pre-book at R200pp and R75 per child (9/10 seater open air game viewer) NO SELF DRIVE PERMITTED
  - 2) MIKE'S HIDE down in the Wildlife section of the farm. Parking space is provided along the main road (signposted)
  - 3) Guests are permitted to CYCLE AND / OR WALK on the entire farm, even on the Wildlife section. Use gate codes as provided.
  - 4) We do not have cycle- and walking routes plotted yet. Please make use of the existing roads and maps.
  - 5) SUNSET VIEWING POINT (signposted) is best visited at sunset at your own leisure. Enjoy a sundowner or little picnic up on the rocks. You can walk all the way around the rock.
- PLEASE DO LEAVE NATURE UNTOUCHED!**
- 6) Full body massages are available to guests right in the bush. Please enquire within.

**LODGE**

- 1) NO PETS permitted on the beds please.
- 2) Units are not serviced during your stay (self catering)
- 3) Smokers please use "sand" ashtrays provided. DO NOT drop your cigarette butts down the deck.
- 4) In your unit is a crate, use this to cart cutlery, crockery etc to the boma for your braai, or use it as a grocery storage unit.  
Please return all items back to your unit.
- 5) Upon departure, please leave the keys in the doors or on the kitchen counters.
- 6) All "lost, broken and damaged" property will be for your account.
- 7) The entire deck and furniture is for lodge residents to enjoy. Please respect and share.  
NO PETS on the furniture please.
- 8) Some furniture items is closed up at night for the dassies / squirrels / bats messing.

**CAMPERS**

- 1) Do not "swop" out your dedicated campsite, unless it is between your group / friends OR arranged.
- 2) We only supply one toilet roll per toilet. Bring more if you think you would need more during your stay. The "Rotsinbos Mall" is stocked too.
- 3) Please do not attempt to "fix" toilets, geysers etc in case of mail functioning or issues.  
Call on management to attend to.

- 4) Each block has its own broom, mop and dish dry rack for your use. PLEASE DO NOT REMOVE!!
- 5) Please place the braai stands in a safe place WHEN MAKING FIRES.

**CAMPSITE ABLUTIONS**

**PRIVATE**

- \* They are not serviced during your stay.
- \* Those fancy gas geysers need electricity to ignite. Unfortunately they were installed prior to loadshedding times.
- \* A10 open air abluion is fitted with a very effective donkey for hot water, to be stoked by yourself (some wood is provided).

**SHARED**

- \* Will be serviced / cleaned on a regular basis.
- \* These gas geysers are not affected by loadshedding.
- \* Washup areas, run the water for rinsing water first until hot water comes through for your dishwashing.

CAMPERS: In from 12pm & Out at 12pm  
BUSH LAPA rental: In from 12pm & Out by 10am
